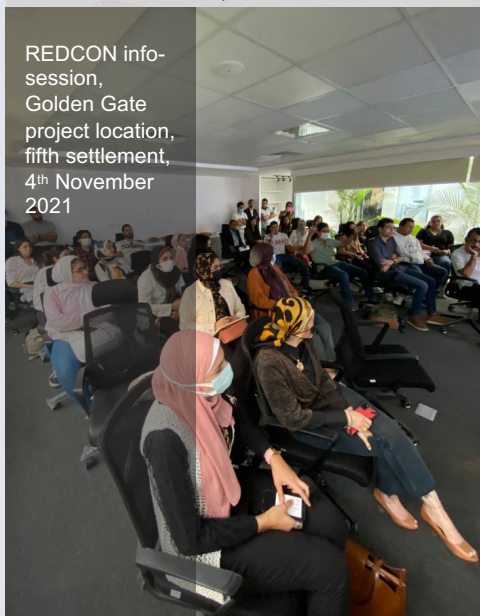

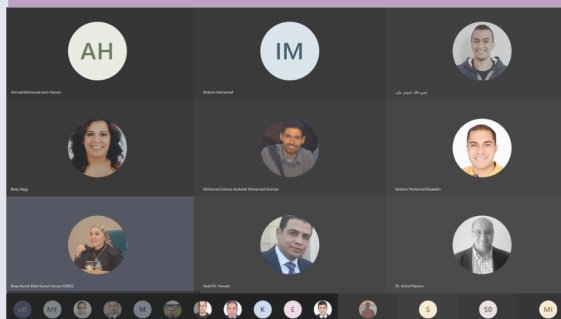
the ACADEMIC Activity: Student Chapter

Academic Advising Workshop: Training System & Psycho- social Role

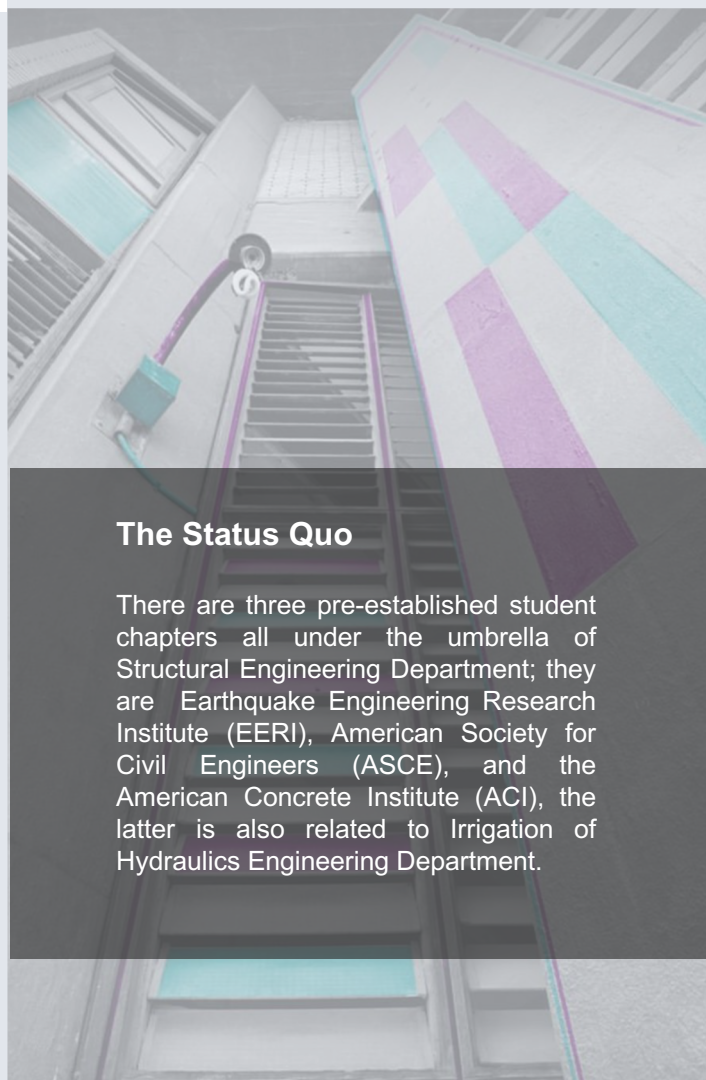

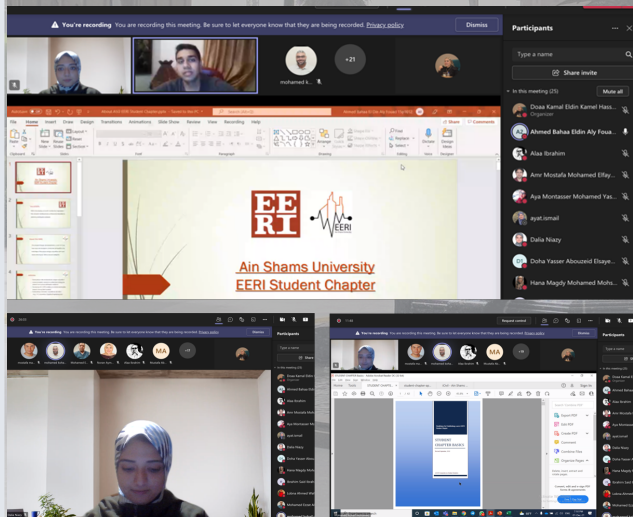
The Status Quo
